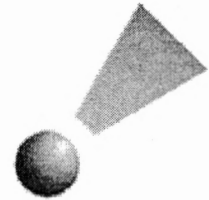




MESSAGE TO THE PARTIES AT COP 10



Foro del Buen Ayre

Mr. President of the Convention of the Parties, Delegates of the Nations committed in saving the planet, ladies and gentlemen.

Ending the 10th Conference of the Parties on Climate Change, in our country, the "Foro del Buen Ayre", formed by 111 Argentine and Latin American NGO's exhorts to all the Delegates to change its attitude, before the lack of significant advances and firm actions in order to achieve the specific objectives of the Protocol and the Convention.

Would be a deep deception for the entire world that in this COP, that promised to be the one of the Adaptation, could not be obtained the necessary agreements in order to relieve the Vulnerability of the countries more affected by extreme climate events. We claims to the parties, particularly to the industrialized world, to integrate the adaptation fund, agreed in previous conferences.

We propose to return to the essence of this conference: REAL EMISSIONS REDUCTION. It is unacceptable that while some of the poorest and vulnerable countries to the Climate Change already are suffering their disastrous consequences, another countries are playing with hypothetical economic damages derived from the possible reduction in the fossil's demand. It delays the negotiations about the conformation and application of adaptation funds.

We exhorts to the parties to include in the seminary all the subjects that are necessary to treat the measures that must be taken in urgent so that the Convention and the Kyoto Protocol obtain their objectives, leaving sectorial interest.

We are worried about the restriction of the civil society and academic sector participation and also discards the treatments of certain thematic in the seminars that was anticipated for the 2005.

These facts give us to understand that an attitude of "deaf ears" exists due to scientific and technical evidences given by IPCC's experts, Institutes and NGO's. The catastrophic results presented during COP10 about actual scenes and future social, economic and environmental lost at short term with quantified amounts.

We request to include within the framework at incise d) article 10 of Kyoto Protocol, the knowledge and the specific discussion about the effects that causes the environmental contamination over the health and the resulting climate change, adopting the corresponding relevant measures: for example only one system for permanent monitory of local and regional epidemic profiles.

We hope that God will enlighten the representatives of the nations that contaminate and their children do not reproach the damage they are doing to the humanity.
