ladies and Gentlemen,

Indonesia as an archipelagic & agricultural country
with about 1700 islands and populations of about
220 millions people and more than 110 million
ha of tropical forest, is very vulnerable to CC.
This threat of CC has serious economic
and social consequences to the country. Amongst
the impacts are the danger of food security,
water shortage, floods and effects on people's health.

In order to support the implementation of the Convention,
and its Protocol, we believe that the developing
countries still requires assistance from the financial
mechanism under the Convention. We would like
to ask for this COP to consider further to GEF on
simplifying the procedures so that developing countries
parties could tap significantly this resources to
foster national development in line with the objectives
of the Convention. The support of financial mechanism
is very important to promote capacity building
technology transfer, public awareness and education.
